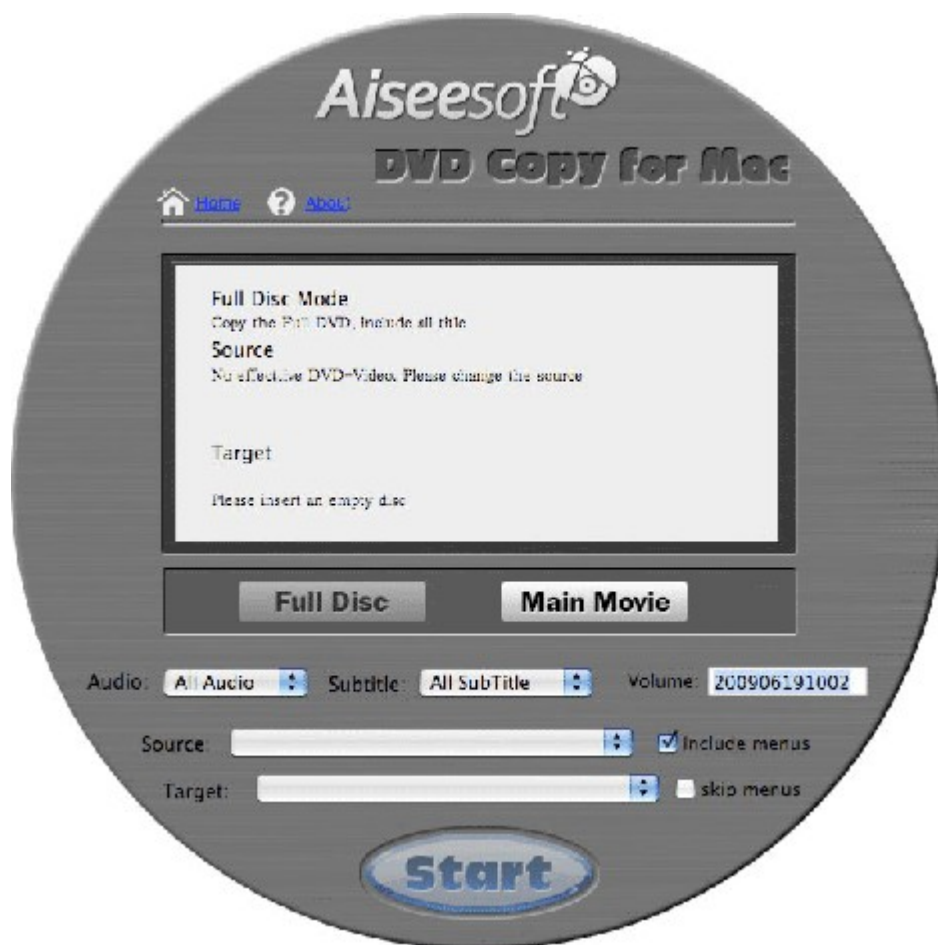


How to Create ISO Image to Backup DVD on Mac?

You'd better create ISO image to backup DVD on Mac just in case that some of your favorite DVD movies became eternally unusable as they were over-scratched. [Aiseesoft DVD Copy for Mac](#) provides you the perfect solution to backup DVD to ISO image on Mac OS X.

Tip: ISO file is an unattached file format which merges a series of files into one single file according to a definite format.

Before creating ISO image to backup DVD, you should [free download](#) for trial. Then install and launch it on your Mac computer.



1, Insert your DVD disc

2, Select the copy DVD mode

Full Disc: Copy the entire DVD, including all the titles;

Main Movie: Copy the longest title contained in DVD, getting rid of the features and the movie trailers.



3, Select the source and choose the target

From the "Source" pop-up menu choose the DVD that you want to copy.

You are available to choose ISO image to backup DVD on Mac



4, After finishing all the basic steps, the software begins creating ISO image by clicking "Start" button.
